



School of Behavioral Sciences Letter of Transferability

Western New Mexico University and El Paso Community College

This agreement provides a mechanism to align the courses listed in the Criminal Justice and Psychology curriculum taught at the El Paso Community College (EPCC) with those courses taught at Western New Mexico University (WNMU). Identifying essential elements for assuring that the course content and delivery are comparable is an important step in facilitating success for students transferring from EPCC into the College of Professional Studies School of Behavioral Sciences Programs at WNMU.

Under this agreement the El Paso Community College agrees to:

1. Have Criminal Justice and Psychology Program faculty, assigned by the appropriate Dean at EPCC, coordinate the content of its Program(s) and course(s) with faculty assigned by the Dean of College of Professional Studies School of Behavioral Sciences at WNMU to ensure that the learning outcomes and assessments of the Criminal Justice and Psychology courses offered at EPCC and WNMU are comparable.
2. Ensure that the assessment process provides continuous quality improvement (CQI) of the Criminal Justice and Psychology Programs.
3. Provide Criminal Justice and Psychology Programs: course syllabi, course outcomes, relevant course material, and textbook information to Western New Mexico University's College of Professional Studies School of Behavioral Sciences faculty for the courses:

Under this agreement, the Western New Mexico University agrees to:

1. Provide Criminal Justice and Psychology Programs course syllabi, course outcomes, relevant course material, and textbook information to EPCC Criminal Justice and Psychology faculty for the courses listed in item 1 immediately above.
2. Arrange for meetings with the WNMU College of Professional Studies School of Behavioral Sciences Criminal Justice and Psychology Programs faculty to discuss course assessment results, WNMU curriculum changes in the fundamental areas, and student-support strategies and opportunities.
3. Provide information to EPCC on the performance of transfer students from EPCC in WNMU College of Professional Studies in School of Behavioral Sciences Criminal Justice and Psychology Programs and on other appropriate learning assessments.



This document will be reviewed on a regular basis to reflect changes in procedures, policies, or curricula. This agreement will become effective when signed by the parties listed below.

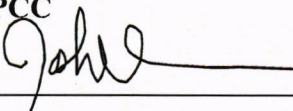


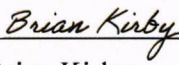
